



## Suspensions Naming United States Federal Buildings

### FLOOR SITUATION

The following bills are being considered on the floor under suspension of the rules and will require a two-thirds majority vote for passage.

These bills are expected to be considered on the floor on June 17, 2008.

### SUMMARY

H.R. 6150 designates the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 14500 Lorain Avenue in Cleveland, Ohio as the "John P. Gallagher Post Office Building". This legislation was introduced by Representative Dennis Kucinich (D-OH) on May 22, 2008. The House Committee on Oversight and Government Reform ordered the bill to be reported by voice vote on June 12, 2008.

H.R. 6085 designates the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 42222 Rancho Las Palmas Drive in Rancho Mirage, California as the "Gerald R. Ford Post Office Building". This legislation was introduced by Representative Mary Bono Mack (R-CA) on May 20, 2008. The House Committee on Oversight and Government Reform ordered the bill to be reported by voice vote on June 12, 2008.
