



## Suspension Naming a United States Federal Building

### FLOOR SITUATION

The following bill is being considered on the floor under suspension of the rules and will require a two-thirds majority vote for passage.

This bill is expected to be considered on the floor on July 22, 2008.

### SUMMARY

H.R. 6226 designates the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 300 East 3<sup>rd</sup> Street in Jamestown, New York, as the "Stan Lundine Post Office Building". This legislation was introduced by Representative Brian Higgins (D-NY) on June 10, 2008. The House Committee on Oversight and Government Reform ordered the bill to be reported by voice vote on July 16, 2008.
