



SUSPENSION NAMING UNITED STATES FEDERAL BUILDINGS

FLOOR SITUATION

The following bills are being considered on the floor under suspension of the rules and will require a two-thirds majority vote for passage.

This legislation is expected to be considered on the floor on September 24, 2008.

SUMMARY

H.R. 6847 designates the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 801 Industrial Boulevard in Ellijay, Georgia, as the "First Lieutenant Noah Harris Ellijay Post Office Building". This legislation was introduced by Representative Nathan Deal (R-GA) on September 9, 2008. The resolution was referred to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform, but was never considered.

S. 3009 designates the Federal Bureau of Investigation building under construction in Omaha, Nebraska, as the "J. James Exon Federal Bureau of Investigation Building". This legislation was introduced by Senator Ben Nelson (D-NE) on May 12, 2008. The Senate passed the bill by unanimous consent on June 24, 2008.
